

TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS
"KROSMAGA – Krosmaga World Series"
FROM NOVEMBER 1, 2017, TO JULY 22, 2018

(Version updated on December 14, December)

1. INTRODUCTION

The company ANKAMA GAMES, located at 75 Boulevard d'Armentières, 59100 Roubaix, France (hereinafter the "**Organizer**") and registered with the Lille Metropolitan Area Companies and Commerce Register (RCS) under the number 492 360 730, is organizing, from November 1, 2017, until July 22, 2018 at 11:59 p.m. (Paris time), an eSport competition for the video game KROSMAGA entitled "Krosmaga World Series" taking place exclusively online (hereinafter the "**Krosmaga World Series**") in accordance with the terms set out in these regulations.

2. ACCEPTANCE OF THESE REGULATIONS

Participation in the Krosmaga World Series implies and entails the unconditional acceptance by the participants of these regulations (hereinafter the "**Regulations**"), the principle of the Krosmaga World Series, and where appropriate, the rules specific to each tournament comprising the Krosmaga World Series, as well as the ethical codes applicable on the Internet. Any person who violates one or more articles of the Regulations, or of the aforementioned conditions and rules will not be eligible for any prize to which (s)he may have been otherwise entitled.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND TERRITORIAL SCOPE

Participation in the Krosmaga World Series is open, subject to the provisions of Article 2 of the Regulations, to any physical person of at least 14 (fourteen) years of age, residing in any territory where the video game KROSMAGA is accessible, with access to an Internet connection and in possession of an Ankama game account, as well as a Toornament account, excluding the Organizer's employees and their family members (spouses, ancestors, descendants, brothers, and sisters).

The Organizer highlights the fact that any minor participating in the Krosmaga World Series is deemed to be participating under the supervision of and with the consent of his/her parents, custodian(s), or legal guardian(s). The Organizer reserves the right to request written proof at any time, and to perform any verifications, as well as to disqualify any participating minor who does not submit such proof immediately, or by a pre-determined deadline.

4. TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

Participation in the Krosmaga World Series requires prior ownership of an Ankama account, as well as an account on the tournament management platform entitled "Toornament", accessible via the website <https://www.toornament.com/> and published by the company OXENT, whose headquarters is located at 2 Rue Paul Vaillant Couturier, 92300 Levallois-Perret, and which is registered with the Nanterre Companies and Commerce Register (RCS) under the number 518 858 378. Participants must then register for the Tournament, at which point participants **MUST provide their in-game usernames**. See the following example: My name is Thomas45, but my in-game username is XxX-Sacri-Fire-XxX, so I need to put this as my "**In-Game Name**":

- XxX-Sacri-Fire-XxX

Participation in the Krosmaga World Series is free of charge.

The [Krosmaga FR Community Discord](#) will be used mainly to communicate, along with Twitter ([@krosmaga](#)) and Facebook (<https://www.facebook.com/Krosmaga>).

Registering under a false identity or someone else's identity, providing false information, or registering under several identities will lead to the cancellation of participation.

Echoing Ankama's General Conditions of Use (GCU), account lending is strictly prohibited. An Ankama account can not be used by several participants, under penalty of disqualification from the Krosmaga World Series by the Organizer, without prejudice to the penalties set out in the GCU.

Moreover, any form of coaching, orally, vocally or written, done by any means of electronic communication or not, is strictly prohibited on all tournaments related to the Krosmaga World Series.

No other mode of participation will be accepted.

Any participation that is fraudulent and/or does not comply with the Regulations will not be taken into consideration, and shall result in the invalidity of the participation. The Organizer reserves the right to perform any verifications in respect of this article or the Regulations as a whole, notably to remove any player having committed wrongdoing of any kind, without, however, being required to systematically verify all players, and may limit such verification to the Krosmaga World Series winners. Any player disqualified in this way does not have any claim to winnings. The Organizer reserves the right to put the prize that would have been unduly allocated to them back into play.

5. FORMAT OF THE KROSMAGA WORLD SERIES

The Krosmaga World Series includes:

- ✓ 7 (seven) tournaments, which will take place after the closure of each season (a season corresponds to 1 [one] month of competition) and will each bring together the 32 (thirty-two) highest players in the rankings (leaderboard) of said season (the "**End-of-Season Tournaments**").
These End-of-Season Tournaments will take place in BO5** Conquest single-elimination format.
For each of these End-of-Season Tournaments, the table will be available on Toornament 2 (two) days before the start of each tournament.
- ✓ 3 (three) tournaments for which participants will not be subject to prior ranking conditions (the "**Open Tournaments**").
The Open Tournaments will take place in BO3* Conquest single-elimination format for the group phases, then in BO5 Conquest single-elimination format.
- ✓ 1 (one) tournament (the "**Open Challenger Tournament**") to which all participants will have access, with the exception of the 30 (thirty) players who have won the most points during the End-of-Season Tournaments and Open Tournaments, and who are therefore already qualified for the Final Tournament. The Open Challenger Tournament will take place in BO3 Conquest single-elimination format for the group phases, then in BO5 Conquest single-elimination format.
- ✓ 1 (one) final tournament bringing together the 32 (thirty-two) players having qualified for this final tournament (the "**Final Tournament**"); this includes the 30 (thirty) players having gained the highest number of points during the End-of-Season Tournaments and Open Tournaments, as well as the 2 (two) winners of the Open Challenger Tournament, giving a total of 32 (thirty-two) players. The Final Tournament will take place in BO5 Conquest single-elimination format for the rounds of 32 and 16, then in BO7*** Conquest single-elimination format for the rest of the tournament.

For all tournaments in the Krosмага World Series:

- ✓ Forbidden cards: Noxine, Kwismas Queen.
- ✓ Authorized cards: all those not forbidden.
- ✓ It is forbidden to take part in any of these tournaments using two (2) separate accounts. Participants' IP addresses may be verified in order to make sure that all participants comply with this rule.

* BO3: the first player to win two (2) matches.

** BO5: the first player to win three (3) matches.

*** BO7: the first player to win four (4) matches.

6. DATES AND TIMES

November End-of-Season Tournament: Saturday and Sunday, December 9 and 10, 2017.

December End-of-Season Tournament: Saturday and Sunday, January 6 and 7, 2018.

Open Tournament No. 1: Saturday and Sunday, January 20 and 21, 2018; and Saturday and Sunday, January 28 and 29, 2018.

January End-of-Season Tournament: Saturday and Sunday, February 10 and 11, 2018.

February End-of-Season Tournament: Saturday and Sunday, March 3 and 4, 2018.

Open Tournament No. 2: Saturday and Sunday, March 17 and 18, 2018; and Saturday and Sunday, March 24 and 25, 2018.

March End-of-Season Tournament: Saturday and Sunday, April 7 and 8, 2018.

April End-of-Season Tournament: Saturday and Sunday, May 5 and 6, 2018.

Open Tournament No. 3: Saturday and Sunday, May 19 and 20, 2018; and Saturday and Sunday, May 26 and 27, 2018.

May End-of-Season Tournament: Saturday and Sunday, June 9 and 10, 2018.

Open Challenger Tournament: Saturday and Sunday, June 23 and 24, 2018; and Saturday and Sunday, June 30 and July 1, 2018.

Final Tournament: Saturday and Sunday, July 14 and 15, 2018; and Saturday and Sunday, July 21 and 22, 2018.

The following times (in Paris time) are given as a guide:

- 3:30 p.m.: Round of 64 (bottom of the bracket)

Saturday of the second weekend concerned:

- 2 p.m.: Round of 16
- 3:30 p.m.: Quarterfinals

Sunday of the second weekend concerned:

- 2 p.m.: Semifinals
- 3:30 p.m.: Semifinals
- 5 p.m.: Final

Final Tournament:

Saturday of the first weekend concerned:

- 2 p.m.: Round of 32
- 3:30 p.m.: Round of 16

Sunday of the first weekend concerned:

- 2 p.m.: Quarterfinal 1
- 3:30 p.m.: Quarterfinal 2

Saturday of the second weekend concerned:

- 3 p.m.: Semifinal 1
- 5 p.m.: Semifinal 2

Sunday of the second weekend concerned:

- 3 p.m.: Third-Place Play-Off
- 5 p.m.: Final

The players must ensure that they are available at the dates and times determined by the Organizer for the matches.

A player's absence or lateness at the aforementioned dates and times shall result in their elimination from the tournament in question.

Players must pay attention to announcements made in the game by the Organizer, particularly those concerning the sequence of matches. It is hereby specified that the players will have a period of at least 20 minutes between the announcement of the match lists and the time at which the matches begin.

7. ENCOUNTER PROCEDURE

For the End-of-Season Tournaments:

Each player must choose 4 (four) gods (i.e. 4 [four] decks) before the tournament starts. Warning: This choice of decks is final, and cannot be modified until the end of the tournament.

Before the start of each match, players must banish 1 (one) of their opponent's 4 (four) decks, with each opponent's deck being banished simultaneously.

For the Open Tournaments and the Open Challenger Tournament:

Up to and including the round of 128, matches are played in BO3: Each player must choose 3 (three) gods (i.e. 3 [three] decks) before the tournament starts. Warning: This choice of decks cannot be modified before the end of the round of 128.

Before the start of each match, players must banish 1 (one) of their opponent's 3 (three) decks, with each opponent's deck being banished simultaneously.

Starting from the round of 64, matches are played in BO5: Each player must choose 4 (four) gods (i.e. 4 [four] decks) before the final starts; these 4 (four) gods may be different from the ones chosen during the first stage of the tournament. Warning: This choice of decks cannot be modified before the end of the tournament.

Before the start of each match, players must banish 1 (one) of their opponent's 4 (four) decks, with each opponent's deck being banished simultaneously.

For the Final Tournament:

For the rounds of 32 and 16, matches are played in BO5 Conquest: Each player must choose 4 (four) gods (i.e. 4 [four] decks) before the round of 32 starts; this choice cannot be modified for the round of 16.

Before the start of each match, players must banish 1 (one) of their opponent's 4 (four) decks, with each opponent's deck being banished simultaneously.

For the rest of the tournament, matches are played in BO7: Each player must choose 5 (five) gods (i.e. 5 [five] decks) before the quarterfinals start; these 5 (five) gods may be different from the ones chosen at the start of the tournament. Warning: This choice of decks cannot be modified before the end of the tournament.

Before the start of each match, players must banish one of their opponent's 5 (five) decks, with each opponent's deck being banished simultaneously.

8. DISCONNECTION AND OTHER ISSUES

In the event of a voluntary disconnection during a game, or the voluntary depart of a player, the game is interrupted and the other player is declared the winner.

Any player who is absent during a call, without mutual consent, for an encounter will be declared forfeit after 15 (fifteen) minutes of waiting, and is therefore eliminated from the tournament.

In the event of adverse incidents beyond the control of players, such as inopportune disconnections or continuous latency issues, the players are permitted and encouraged to come to an arrangement to conclude the match. If an arrangement cannot be agreed on, the players can use Discord to contact the tournament administrator, who can make any decision necessary to end the match (have the players redo the match, or declare one of them the winner, or any other decision). The administrator's decision is final.

9. INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR

All participants agree to respect the code of conduct as set out in the Regulations. The Organizer reserves the right to take any appropriate disciplinary measures in the case of non-compliance with the code of conduct, whether it concerns a behavior listed in the Regulations or behavior that is disruptive or likely to disrupt the smooth operation of the game. The sanctions are as follows: warning, penalty (match forfeit), disqualification.

Any unsporting, aggressive, insulting, or other inappropriate behavior will be sanctioned by the Organizer. You can report any prejudicial behavior or content to the Krosmaga World Series administrator by contacting them on Discord. The administrator is authorized to take any action deemed necessary to put an end to the damage and may also apply the sanctions set out in the Regulations.

The Organizer has the authority to make any decision concerning the operation of the Krosmaga World Series and the participants, and may also modify the Regulations at any time in accordance with the conditions below. The information will be available on the Krosmaga website (<https://www.krosmaga.com/en/prehome>) as soon as possible.

10. STREAM BROADCASTING

So you can follow the Krosmaga World Series's progression, a stream will be set up on the **krosmagaofficiel** channel, which will broadcast some of the matches played. We therefore request that the selected players add the account used to broadcast the tournament so they can watch their matches as spectators. The stream will have a delay of thirty (30) minutes in order to avoid any stream-hacking. Any complaint involving stream-hacking will be analyzed, but will not be accepted without substantiated evidence. We would also like to remind you that shoutcasters are not referees, so please do not treat them as such; instead, contact the referees using the Krosmaga Community Discord. A list of referees will, however, be made available on the stream, for information purposes. Each player is free to stream their participation in the tournament, but players should be aware that by so doing they may be vulnerable to stream-hacking and other dishonest behavior. They thereby accept the consequences.

11. PRIZES

11.1 Prize Descriptions

Regarding the End-of-Season Tournament:

The prizes to be won in each of the End-of-Season Tournaments are as follows: cash prizes totaling €3,000, as well as 144 points.

Regarding the Open Tournaments:

The prizes to be won in each of the Open Tournaments are as follows: 310 Necros and Paladirs Boosters, 128 Gold Boosters, 384 Silver Boosters, 384 Bronze Boosters (plus a Bronze Booster for each participant from 513th place on down), a Noxine for each participant, 119,400 kamas, cash prizes totaling €3,000, and 224 points.

Regarding the Open Challenger Tournament:

The prizes to be won are as follows: 310 Necros and Paladirs Boosters, 128 Gold Boosters, 384 Silver Boosters, 384 Bronze Boosters (plus a Bronze Booster for each participant from 513th place on down), a Noxine for each participant, 119,400 kamas, and two qualifying places for the Final Tournament.

Regarding the Final Tournament:

The prizes to be won are as follows: cash prizes totaling €15,000.

128th to 65th places: 500 kamas (€5) and 1 Noxine (€0.50) (Total value: €5.50)

64th to 33rd places: 500 kamas (€5), 5 Necros and Paladirs Boosters (€5), and 1 Noxine (€0.50) (Total value: €10.50)

32nd to 17th places: 1,000 kamas (€10), 5 Necros and Paladirs Boosters (€5), and 1 Noxine (€0.50) (Total value: €15.50)

16th to 9th places: 2,000 kamas (€20), 5 Necros and Paladirs Boosters (€5), and 1 Noxine (€0.50) (Total value: €25.50)

256th to 129th places: 1 Gold Booster (€3.00), 1 Silver Booster (€1.20), 1 Bronze Booster (€0.60), and 1 Noxine (€0.50) (Total value: €5.30)
128th to 65th places: 500 kamas (€5) and 1 Noxine (€0.50) (Total value: €5.50)
64th to 33rd places: 500 kamas (€5), 5 Necros and Paladirs Boosters (€5), and 1 Noxine (€0.50) (Total value: €10.50)
32nd to 17th places: 1,000 kamas (€10), 5 Necros and Paladirs Boosters (€5), and 1 Noxine (€0.50) (Total value: €15.50)

Regarding the Final Tournament:

The prizes will be distributed as follows:

1st place: €7,500; 2nd place: €3,000; 3rd place: €1,500; 4th place: €1,000; 5th to 8th places: €500 each.

For each of the Krosмага World Series tournaments:

The payment of prizes in euros will take place one month after the end of each tournament, on condition that the player provides all the necessary details to proceed with said payment by two weeks after the end of said tournament at the latest. In the case of players who are minors, the Organizer will contact the legal representative of each such player to organize the terms of the payment of the share owed to said player.

Digital prizes will be allocated to players one week after the end of the tournament.

The Organizer cannot be held responsible for any errors or omissions made by the players in the information requested at the time of creation of an Ankama account or at the time of participation, nor for the absence of response from the winners to the information request email sent by the Organizer, where applicable, nor for any IT errors.

12. COMPLAINTS

Prizes cannot be reimbursed, replaced, or exchanged, under any circumstances whatsoever, even in the event of force majeure. Prizes are not subject to a guarantee.

The Organizer cannot be held responsible if, for reasons beyond its control, the competition, its terms and/or the prizes must be delayed, modified or cancelled, in part or in whole.

13. SUBMISSION OF REGULATIONS

A copy of the Regulations can be provided free of charge to any person who requests it. Postal fees related to any requests for a copy of the Regulations will be reimbursed provided that these requests are made in writing and sent via postal mail to the Organizer, and that they include the full personal information of whoever is making the request (first and last name, address, postal code, city/town). This is limited to one request of the same type per household (same last name and address). These fees are reimbursed on the basis of the regular mail rate for under 20 grams on the day these regulations take effect.

14. CNIL (DATA PROTECTION AND CIVIL LIBERTIES) PROVISIONS

Data of a personal nature that you may be asked to provide by the Organizer, namely, where applicable, email address, first and last name and postal address, are required for participation to be taken into account, for the determination of the winners, for the allocation of prizes, and for the verification of compliance with participation rules. This information is for the Organizer. In accordance with the French Data Protection Act ("Informatique et Libertés") of January 6, 1978, Art. L.27, each player has the right to access, correct or delete information concerning him or her, upon simple written request sent to the Organizer.

15. RIGHT TO ONE'S IMAGE AND/OR NAME

In general terms, participants (or their legal representatives if the participants are minors or under guardianship) grant, without any financial or other type of compensation from the Organizer or any other entity within the Ankama Group, the right to publish, disseminate and reproduce their image(s)/photo(s) on the Internet, and use them for promotional purposes, as appropriate.

Simply by participating in the Krosmaga World Series, all players (or their legal representatives if the players are minors or under guardianship) authorize, without any financial or other type of compensation, the Organizer and any entity within the Ankama Group to reproduce, use, disseminate, and publish their image(s)/photo(s), first and last names, and/or usernames on the Internet, notably on the websites of the Ankama Group, to announce the winners.

16. DISPUTES AND LIABILITIES

Participation implies the understanding and acceptance of the characteristics or limitations of the Internet, the absence of protection of certain data against possible misappropriation or piracy, and risks of contamination by any viruses that may be present on the network. It is, therefore, the responsibility of each player to take all appropriate measures to protect his or her data.

The Organizer will not be held responsible in the event that a malfunctioning of the Internet network prevents access to the Krosmaga World Series or its proper operation. Players are responsible for the security and the stability of their Internet connection. Any defeat resulting from a connection problem or external attacks will not be sufficient grounds to relaunch the fight, and the Organizer will not be held responsible for any damages caused.

In the case of a computer virus, external attack, fraud, or technical malfunction, the Organizer reserves the right to cancel or modify the terms of the Krosmaga World Series at its discretion and shall not be held liable therefor by the players. It reserves the right, under such circumstances, to not allocate the prizes and/or to bring proceedings before the competent courts against the parties who have committed such acts of fraud.

The Organizer will have the final decision on any dispute relating to the Krosmaga World Series and to its Regulations. No reply will be given to any request by telephone or in writing concerning the interpretation or application of these Regulations, the mechanisms or terms of the Krosmaga World Series, or the allocation of the prizes.

The Organizer reserves the right, if the circumstances so require, to shorten, extend, modify, or cancel this Krosmaga World Series. It cannot be held liable as a result. In particular, the Organizer reserves the right, where applicable, to invalidate and/or cancel all or part of the Krosmaga World Series if it appears that instances of fraud or malfunctions have occurred in any form whatsoever. Any inaccurate or false declaration and/or any fraud will result in the disqualification of the player(s) in question. Under such circumstances, the Organizer reserves the right to block access, to not distribute the prize to the person committing the fraud, and/or to bring legal proceedings against any participant who has committed or attempted to commit fraud. Non-exhaustively, a person committing fraud is defined as:

- Any person who has registered under a false identity;
- Any person who has registered a third-party; and/or
- Any person who has taken part in the tournament using two separate accounts.

The Organizer cannot be held liable for the above, and the players cannot therefore claim any compensation or indemnity of any nature whatsoever.

17. APPLICABLE LAW & SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

These Regulations are subject exclusively to French law.

Any dispute or claim in relation to this Tournament must be submitted in writing and sent to the address given in Article 8. No dispute or claim will be taken into consideration after a deadline of one (1) month after the closure of the Krosmaga World Series.

Jurisdiction over any dispute arising from the execution or the interpretation of these Regulations lies with the competent courts of the Lille Metropolitan Area, even in the event of multiple defendants, incidental claims, or third-party proceedings.
