

CONTEST RULES
"Ankama Editions Prize"
FROM APRIL 30 TO SEPTEMBER 12, 2025

1. DESCRIPTION

ANKAMA EDITIONS, a simplified joint-stock company with a share capital of €250,000, Lille Metropolitan Area Companies and Commerce Register number 492 360 169, with its registered office at 75 Boulevard d'Armentières, 59100 Roubaix (hereinafter the "**Organizer**"), is organizing, from April 30 to September 12, 2025, 11:59 p.m. (Paris time), a free contest with no purchase necessary called "Prix Ankama Editions" (hereinafter the "**Contest**") according to the terms and conditions described in these rules.

The Contest and its promotion are managed or sponsored by Facebook, X, or Instagram. In this context, the Organizer absolves Facebook, X, and Instagram of all liability in connection with any aspect relating to the Contest. Participants provide information to the Organizer and not to Facebook, X or Instagram.

2. ACCEPTANCE OF THESE RULES

By participating in the Contest, you accept and agree, without reservation, to fully comply with these rules, the Contest's concept, the Terms of Use of Facebook, X, or Instagram, and any applicable ethical rules on the Internet. Any person violating one or more of these Rules, terms, or conditions will be ineligible to participate in the Contest and will forfeit any prizes they may otherwise have won.

3. CAPACITY AND REGIONAL RESTRICTIONS

The Contest is open to any individual worldwide, aged 12 years or over, with Internet access, except for members of the Organizer's staff or their family members (spouses, ascendants, descendants, and siblings) (the "**Participant**").

You are advised that any minor or legally protected person participating in the Contest is deemed to be participating under the supervision and with the consent of their parents, custodian(s), or legal guardian(s) (hereinafter the "**Legal Representative(s)**").

The Organizer reserves the right to request written proof thereof from Participants at any time, perform any verifications to this effect, and disqualify any Participant who does not submit such proof immediately or by a predetermined deadline, as the case may be.

4. ABOUT THIS CONTEST

To celebrate its 20th anniversary, Ankama Editions is organizing a creation contest. Send us 5 to 20 manga or graphic novel pages or webtoon panels (50 maximum) from a story of your creation inspired by the theme "*Osamodas: The Bestial Pact*". Your creation must be a "one shot", in other words, a complete story with a beginning and an end, which is not part of a series. After deliberation by a jury consisting of several members of Ankama's teams, including ToT (Anthony Roux), one participant will be declared the winner! They will win several prizes, including the publication of their creation in webtoon format on the Allscreen app. Be creative and try to win the prizes up for grabs!

5. TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

The Contest takes place exclusively online.

To enter the Contest, the Participant must create an artwork (hereinafter the "**Entry**") presenting the following characteristics:

- The Entry must consist of 5 to 20 complete manga or graphic novel pages or webtoon panels, including both script and artwork (50 maximum);
- The Entry must be a complete story with a start and a finish. It must be completely novel and original and be inspired by the theme "*Osamodas: The Bestial Pact*". The Participant can find information on this theme on the website: <https://www.ankama.com/en/prix-ankama-editions/reglement-EN.pdf>;
- The Entry may be in color or black and white;
- The Entry must be produced in SP, TIFF or CLIP format. Drawings, speech bubbles, and onomatopoeia must each be placed on separate layers. The Entry must be at a resolution of 300dpi.

The use of artificial intelligence software is strictly forbidden.

The Entry can be created by one Participant or by two Participants working together. In the latter case, the prizes will be awarded following the conditions described in Article 6 of these Rules.

The Entry must then be converted into PDF format or into several JPEG not exceeding 72dpi and sent as an email attachment to prixconcours@ankama.com. The file containing the Entry sent in this manner must not exceed 36Mb.

It is hereby specified that, should the Organizer select the Entry, the Participant will be required to subsequently provide a high-definition version for publication purposes.

Entries not submitted in accordance with these Rules will not be considered.

The Participant must submit the Entry **between 30 April 2025 and 12 September 2025 at 11:59 p.m.** (Paris time). Any entries received after this date and time will not be considered.

Only one Artwork per Participant or pair of Participants will be accepted. Only one email address per Participants or pair of Participants will be accepted. If more than one entry is received, the Organizer may, at its discretion, choose to retain one, or it may simply decide to disqualify all of the Participant's entries.

Any Entry deemed to be of insufficient quality or unsuitable for publication will be disqualified. Additionally, any Entry deemed off-topic, inappropriate, incomprehensible, vulgar, pornographic, racist, homophobic, or in any way contrary to law or common decency will be disqualified immediately.

In general, the Entry submitted to the Organizer must not contain trademarks, logos, photographs, illustrations, passages of literary works, music, full or partial reproduction of any existing work, or any other kind of third-party intellectual property unless otherwise permitted by these Rules.

Accordingly, during the Contest, Participants are expressly prohibited from sending anything, borrowing or using elements subject to third-party intellectual or industrial property rights without prior express consent.

Entries may not contain visual elements violating privacy or third-party image rights. In the event that visual elements depict third parties, the Participants must obtain their prior consent.

Registering under a false identity or the identity of another person, providing false information, or registering under more than one identity will result in disqualification.

Any Entries received late, containing incomplete or false information, and/or not abiding by these rules will not be considered and will be disqualified. The Organizer reserves the right to perform any verifications under this article and the Rules in their entirety, for example, to verify whether a Participant has committed wrongdoing. However, the Organizer has no obligation to systematically verify all Participants and may limit such verification to the Contest winners. Any Participant disqualified in this manner may not claim any winnings. The Organizer reserves the right to put back into play any prize unduly awarded to a disqualified Participant.

NOTWITHSTANDING THE TERMS ABOVE, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE ORGANIZER, ENTRIES MAY BE POSTED ONLINE AND/OR REPRODUCED IN WHOLE OR IN PART ON ONE OR MORE WEBSITES BELONGING TO THE ANKAMA GROUP, ON ITS OFFICIAL PAGES, ON SOCIAL MEDIA AND ONLINE STREAMING SITES, AND/OR ON ANY OF THE ANKAMA GROUP'S YOUTUBE AND/OR TWITCH CHANNELS ONCE THEY HAVE BEEN SUBMITTED TO THE ORGANIZER, WHICH ALL CONTEST PARTICIPANTS (AND THEIR LEGAL REPRESENTATIVES, IF MINORS) EXPRESSLY ACKNOWLEDGE AND ACCEPT. FOR THIS PURPOSE, THE RIGHTS TO THE ENTRIES WILL BE TRANSFERRED TO THE ORGANIZER AS SET FORTH IN ARTICLE 11 HEREUNDER.

ENTRIES CANNOT BE RETURNED TO PARTICIPANTS UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.

THE WINNING ENTRY MAY BE PUBLISHED ON THE ALLSKREEN WEBSITE AND APP.

6. PRIZES

6.1 *Prize Descriptions*

The prize* to be won as part of the Contest (hereinafter referred to as the "**Prize**") is the following:

Prize: the publication** of the winning Entry in webtoon format on the Allskreen website and app + €1,000 (one thousand) *** + an exclusive trophy (prize with no commercial value) + a visit to the Organizer's premises in Roubaix ****, scheduled for 3 October 2025.

Total Prize Value: €1,000

Number of winners: 1 (one) or 2 (two)*****, if the Entry is collaborative, as permitted under Article 5.

TO RECEIVE THIS PRIZE, THE WINNER MUST SUBMIT THE RELEASE FORM TO THE ORGANIZER, DULY COMPLETED AND SIGNED BY THEMSELVES AND, WHERE APPLICABLE, THEIR LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE, WHICH WILL BE PROVIDED TO THEM BY THE ORGANIZER.

** The winning prize is strictly personal and, therefore, cannot be sold, exchanged, loaned, assigned, or granted to or benefit any third party, ascendant, descendant, beneficiary, or other person for any reason except as otherwise stated by the Organizer.*

The Organizer reserves the right to suspend, cancel, or delete any prize (in whole or in part) if it suspects that any of the aforementioned actions has been performed or attempted, for as long as the prize is valid.

The Prize includes only what is specifically described, and no other benefit.

Winners may not claim any compensation in the future if and when the Allskreen app stops being published and/or distributed in its current, or any other, form.

***** The winner – and their legal representative, if a minor – and more generally the Participants acknowledge and expressly agree that the Entry can be published in webtoon format on the Allskreen website and app.***

THE WINNER – AND THEIR LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE, IF A MINOR – EXPRESSLY AGREE(S) AND ACKNOWLEDGE(S) THAT THEIR ENTRY IS SUBJECT TO MODIFICATION AND ADAPTATION FOR TECHNICAL AND/OR ARTISTIC REASONS (IF DEEMED NECESSARY BY THE ORGANIZER), PARTICULARLY

FOR ADAPTION TO WEBTOON FORMAT, AND MAY BE GRAPHICALLY EDITED PRIOR TO DISSEMINATION. ACCORDINGLY, AS PART OF THEIR ENTRY, THE PARTICIPANT IS ADVISED THAT THEIR FIRST NAME, LAST NAME, AND/OR ANKAMA NICKNAME MAY BE USED TOGETHER WITH THE CAPTION "WINNER OF THE ANKAMA EDITIONS PRIZE" OR ANY OTHER CAPTION CHOSEN BY THE ORGANIZER.

***** This prize will be paid by bank transfer to an account held by the winning Participant. For this purpose, the winner must provide the Organizer with a valid bank account details for the account to which they wish the sum to be transferred, along with a valid official document confirming their identity.**

In the event that a winner is under the age of 16 and still subject to mandatory school attendance, the Organizer will pay the amount of the prize due to them into an account opened by the minor's legal representative at the Caisse des Dépôts et Consignations (Deposits and Consignments Fund). In the event that a winner is a minor over the age of 16, the Organizer will contact the winner's legal representative to make the arrangements for the disbursement of the sum owed to this winner. The minor and their legal representative will both have to provide proof of identity by producing a copy of an official document.

Said official document must be legible and include the last name, first name, date and place of birth, photograph and signature of the holder, as well as the dates of issue and expiry of the document, and the issuing authority.

After receiving the cash prize, the winner must fill out and sign a receipt provided by the Organizer, and send this receipt to the Organizer within one month at the latest of receipt of the prize.

****** The visit to the Organizer's premises includes:**

- Up to €200 (two hundred euros), including tax, OUTBOUND TRAVEL from the train station or airport closest to the winner's place of residence to Roubaix, and RETURN TRAVEL from Roubaix to the train station or airport closest to the winner's place of residence for 1 (one) person (hereinafter, the "Trip"). The Organizer is solely responsible for choosing the means of transportation for the Trip, and the Organizer reserves the right to combine multiple means of transportation. Organizing and reserving the Trip will be done by the Organizer.**
- Breakfast for 1 (one) person on the day of the visit, organized by the Organizer.**
- Accommodation for 1 (one) person, but only in cases where it is deemed necessary due to the non-availability of transportation, and for a maximum of 2 (two) nights, organized and reserved by the Organizer, with the choice of the type, options and location of the accommodation being at the sole discretion of the Organizer;**
- the outbound journey from the Organizer's premises to the Festival des Livres d'en Haut in Lille and the return journey from the premises of the Festival des Livres d'en Haut to either the nearest train station or airport if the winner's return travel to their home is on the same day, or to the winner's accommodation for the night of October 3 to 4 , 2025.**

The winner will need to provide the information necessary to make the reservations as soon as possible. Any winner who does not respond within 3 (three) days of when the Organizer contacts them to confirm the details of the Trip may forfeit their award, in whole or in part.

If the winner is under the age of majority, they must imperatively send the Organizer, prior to the reservation of transportation and lodging, the parental authorization form and liability waiver furnished by the Organizer, duly completed and signed by his/her parents, custodian(s), or legal guardian(s).

ALL PARTICIPANTS ARE HEREBY INFORMED THAT TRANSPORTATION AND ACCOMMODATION ARE STRICTLY PERSONAL AND THAT THE ORGANIZER WILL NOT COVER THE COST, EITHER IN PART OR IN WHOLE, OF TRANSPORTATION, MEALS AND/OR ACCOMMODATION FOR ANY PERSON ACCOMPANYING THE WINNER. unless otherwise decided by the Organizer (for instance, if the winner is a minor).

It is the winner's sole responsibility to verify that the documents and paperwork necessary for him/her to receive the prize are in order and that he/she is available on the scheduled day. The Organizer may not be held responsible should the winner does not have the necessary valid documents and paperwork in order or does not make him- or herself available to receive the prize, in which case the prize shall be deemed forfeit.

Should the winner be unable to or not wish to take possession of the prize, he/she shall not be entitled to compensation of any sort.

The Organizer shall not be held responsible for any delays, cancellations, strikes or other events outside its control that may affect the chosen means of transportation.

The Organizer only agrees to cover the winner's travel costs for the Trip and meals up to a total maximum amount of two hundred (200) euros including tax. If the value of expenses incurred exceeds this sum of 200 (two hundred) euros including tax, the winner in question must cover the overage out of their own pocket.

The date of the visit has been scheduled for October 3, 2025. The exact dates and times of departure and return will be determined later by the Organizer in consultation with the winner, taking into account the latter's availability. However, if no agreement can be reached in good faith between the winner and the Organizer, or the winner does not respond to the Organizer within the necessary time frame, the prize shall be forfeit.

The Organizer reserves the right to modify this date due to changes in the teams' schedules or for any other reason. In which case, the winner shall be notified in a timely manner. Any winner who does not respond within 3 (three) days of when the Organizer contacts them to confirm the details of the Trip may forfeit their award, in whole or in part.

****** If the winning Entry was created collaboratively by two Participants, the Prize will be awarded as follows: the Entry will be published on the Allskreen website and app + both Participants will each receive a trophy + they will both be invited to visit the Organizer's premises under the conditions outlined above + the sum of €1,000 (one thousand) will be shared equally between the two Participants (unless a written agreement between the two Participants stipulates an alternative distribution method which is communicated to the Organizer).*

6.2 Terms for Awarding Prizes/Determining Winners

In the days following the Contest, a jury composed of the Organizer's staff members will select the best Entry based on criteria such as originality, workmanship, and adherence to the theme. The Participant or the pair of Participants who created this Entry will be designated as the winner and will receive the Prize.

The Organizer reserves the right not to select any Entry, at its sole discretion.

The name of the winner (or winning pair) will be announced in the weeks following the end of the Contest, on the Organizer's various websites and social media platforms, and possibly in the Organizer's newsletters. It will also be announced during the opening evening of the Festival des Livres d'en Haut, which will take place on October 3, 2025 in Lille. The winner(s) will also be contacted by the Organizer by email, using the email address provided for the Entry. On this occasion, the Organizer may request all information necessary for the awarding of the Prize, as well as a high-definition publishable version of their Entry (in PSD, TIFF or CLIP format, with drawings, speech bubbles, and onomatopoeia on separate layers, at a resolution of 300dpi).

No email will be sent to non-winning Participants or to any winner who has provided incomplete or unusable contact details.

The various rewards comprising the Prize will be awarded under the conditions specified in Article 6.1. The trophy will be presented on October 3, 2025 during the opening evening of the Festival des Livres d'en Haut. If the winner is unable to attend this event, the trophy will be presented during their visit to the Organizer's premises, or will be sent by post to the address provided to the Organizer.

The Organizer cannot be held responsible for any errors or omissions made by Participants regarding information requested when entering, nor for a lack of response or incomplete response from the winner to the request for information sent by the Organizer by email, where applicable, nor for any computer malfunctions, nor for delayed or lost deliveries on the part of the French Postal Service or any other shipping service chosen to send the prizes, where applicable.

7. COMPLAINTS

Prizes, in whole or in part, cannot be reimbursed, replaced, or exchanged, and no cash equivalent will be awarded under any circumstances whatsoever, even in the event of force majeure. Prizes, in whole or in part, cannot be transferred to third parties. Prizes, in whole or in part, are not subject to any warranty, and the winner(s) agree to hold the Organizer harmless regarding the prizes, in particular with regard to their qualities or any consequences arising out of the possession of a prize.

The Organizer cannot be held liable for any incidents/accidents arising out of the use of the prizes, in whole or in part.

Prizes returned due to any difficulty will not be re-awarded or resent and will remain the property of the Organizer. In such case, the winner forfeits the benefit of their prize, and the Organizer cannot be held liable.

The Organizer cannot be held responsible if, for reasons beyond its control, the operation, its terms and conditions, and/or the prizes must be delayed, modified, or canceled, in whole or in part.

GENERAL NOTE: In the event a Prize is not available, in whole or in part, the Organizer cannot in any way be held responsible, regardless of the reason the Prize is not available, in whole or in part. The Organizer agrees, however, to replace any full or partial prize that it is unable to provide with a prize of equal or greater commercial value, except in cases where such inability is due to force majeure or reasons attributable to the Participant.

The Rules may be amended by the Organizer at any time and posted on the Contest website. Any updates will be effective as soon as they are posted, and, by participating in the Contest, all participants will be considered to have consented thereto as of the effective date. Participants rejecting any updates will no longer be eligible to participate in the Contest.

Postage for any copy requests will be reimbursed within fifteen (15) days from the end of the Contest, as postmarked. Requests must be submitted to the Organizer in writing on plain paper and include the requesting party's complete information (first and last name, address, postal code, town/city). Requests are limited to one per household (same last name and address). These fees are reimbursed on the basis of the regular mail rate on the day these regulations take effect.

9. REIMBURSEMENT OF CONTEST COSTS

Notwithstanding the provisions hereunder, any Participant can be reimbursed for the costs to enter the Contest by submitting a written request online. Reimbursement will be issued as a lump-sum payment based on a five-minute (5) connection. Reimbursement requests must be mailed to the address set forth in Article 8, above, and include the requesting party's first and last names and mailing address, along with a photocopy of the invoice from the Participant's Internet service provider for the month in question, proof of subscription, and a letter stating the number of the analog or digital line (of the decoder if a cable subscription) used to participate, the connection date and time, or any other items showing the connection between the entry and the reimbursement request, no later than fifteen (15) days from the end of the Contest, as postmarked. Postage paid by the Participant to mail the reimbursement request will be reimbursed based on the current regular postage rate. Postage reimbursement requests must be submitted in writing along with the aforementioned reimbursement request. Requests are limited to one per household (same last name and address). Late or incomplete requests will not be considered. Costs will be reimbursed by check and/or by sending a stamp, at the Organizer's discretion.

Nowadays, as part of their IT and Internet services, some service providers offer free or subscription-based access to users. Participants are advised that any access to the Contest using a free or subscription-based service (for example, a connection via cable, ADSL, fiber optics, etc.) cannot be reimbursed, since the subscription to the provider's services in this case is theoretically purchased by the user for general Internet access and, thus, by connecting to the Organizer's website to participate in the Contest, the Participant incurs no additional cost or expense.

You may also contact our data protection officer at the same addresses. If, however, you believe that we have not met your expectations, you may submit a complaint with a competent data protection supervisory authority.

11. ASSIGNMENT OF COPYRIGHT/NEIGHBORING RIGHTS/IMAGE RIGHTS & PARTICIPANT'S WARRANTIES

By entering this Contest, each Participant – and their legal representative, if a minor – accept(s) in advance that their Entry may be reproduced and posted, free of charge, by the Organizer and/or any entities of the Ankama Group on any of their forms of media such as Facebook, Twitter/X, YouTube, Twitch, Dailymotion, websites, forums, blogs, discussion platforms, or other social media created or hosted by the Organizer and/or any entities of the Ankama Group, during and after the Contest, and Participants will receive no compensation or benefit for such use. Please note that, given the nature of the Internet, Entries will remain online and accessible after the Contest, but the Organizer and/or any entities of the Ankama Group will make no new posts. The Organizer reserves the right to disqualify any Participant violating any of these Rules.

By entering the Contest, Participants, including the winner – and their Legal Representative, if minors – authorize the Organizer to use their names and/or images as part of the Contest, for example, to announce the winners.

The use of Participants' and the winner's names and/or images and their Entries submitted as part of the Contest, including the winning Entry, does not, under these Rules, entitle Participants or the winner to any right or financial compensation for their benefit, except for the prizes at stake.

The Organizer cannot be held liable in any way in any claim or action brought by anyone for any reason with respect to any content or rights relating to the Entries submitted by the Participants as part of the Contest.

The Organizer cannot be held liable for comments made by Internet users about any Entries disseminated as part of the Contest.

The Organizer is not liable in the event of misuse or an incident involving the use of a computer, Internet access, maintenance, or arising from any malfunction on any Contest servers, telephone lines, or other technical connections.
